Introduction

Like every year, Baba Educational Society Institute of Paramedical College of Nursing started the session 2019-2020 with aim of "Uplift the medical education among females and rural background".

Academic Excellence

This year Baba Educational Society Institute of Paramedical College of Nursing offered new post graduate M.Sc. Nursing (2 years) programme along with B.Sc. Nursing (4 years degree program), GNM (3 years diploma course) and ANM (2 years certificate course). We can currently train 80 M.Sc. Nursing, 320 B.Sc. Nursing, 120 ANM and 180 GNM students. Every year, we produce 80 B.Sc. Nursing, 60 GNM and 60 ANM best professional nurses in whole state.

We maintained the staff student ratio 1:10 as per the Indian Nursing Council norms. All the departments headed by Professors and supported by Associate professor, Assistant professor and Nursing Tutor. College had given importance to student centric teaching and learning method. Practical orientation and training was conducted by using various simulators in laboratory. Baba hospital is a main source of knowledge where the students learn the real life scenario, so, students were posted for the same. Our Library was equipped with books of latest edition with online journals. Also, Wi Fi service was provided to students.
