- 4.4. The Institution shall share the details of the students in the format given by EbekMed for creation of login credentials.
- 4.5. The Institution shall provide proper space and seating allocation for the EbekMed trainer.
- 4.6. The Institution shall not employ or use EbekMed trainers for 3 years from the end of this agreement.
- 4.7. The Institution shall provide audio-visual facilities in the classrooms.
- 4.8. The Institution shall provide high speed internet for the conduct of classes and exams.
- 4.9. The Institution shall appoint a coordinator for the smooth process of the programme.
- 4.10. The Institution shall select a date for the final exams.
- 4.11. The Institution shall provide classrooms with high-speed Wi-Fi internet for the conduct of final exams.

The Institution shall distribute the certificates to the students on receipt of the same from EbekMed.

5. COMMERCIAL TERMS

- 5.1. The course fees for the various levels are listed in Annexure II and will be applicable for each academic year.

6. PAYMENT TERMS

6.1. The students shall pay in the fees directly to the Ebek as follows:

9.1.2. In the event of any lawful authority ordering the Parties to terminate this MoU.

10. APPLICABLE LAW AND ARBITRATION

10.1. This Agreement shall be governed by Indian law.

10.2. Any dispute arising out of or in connection with this MoU, including any question regarding its existence, validity or termination, shall be referred to and finally resolved by arbitration at Chennai, India in accordance with the Indian Arbitration and



Conciliation Act, 1996. The arbitration shall be conducted by three (3) arbitrators with each Party appointing an arbitrator and the two arbitrators so appointed appointing the third and presiding arbitrator. The language of the arbitration shall be English.

10.3. No Party shall disclose to any third party except legal advisors the existence, nature, content, or outcome of any arbitration, or purported arbitration, brought in respect of this MOU.

The workshop was concluded with Mr. Hemendra Pal Singh Sir, Professor of Baba College of Nursing by delivering a vote of thanks.

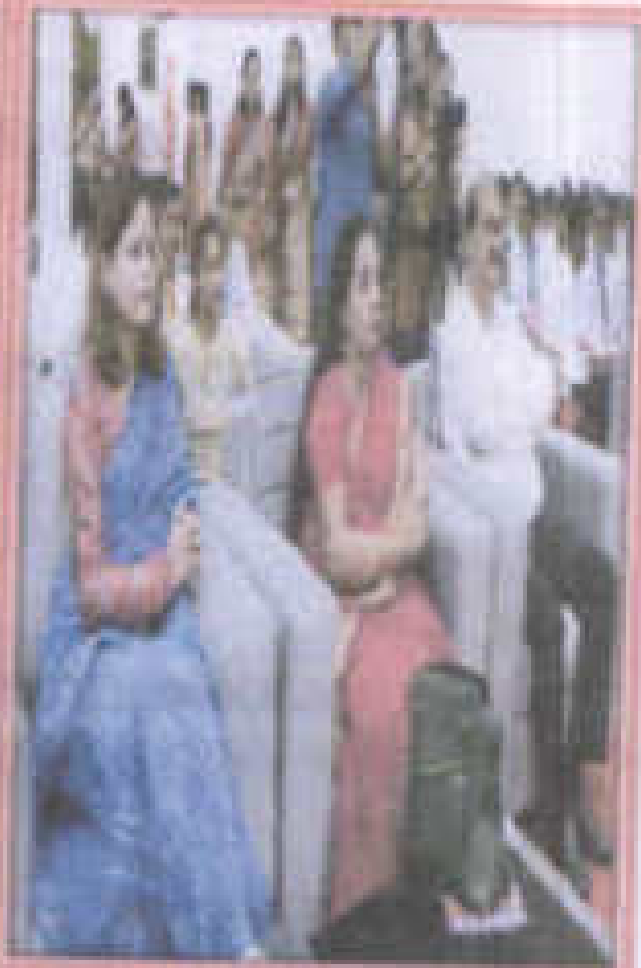

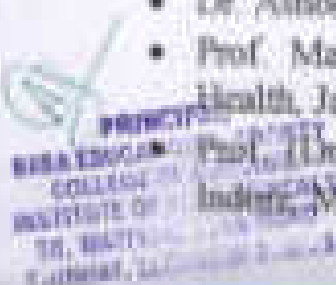

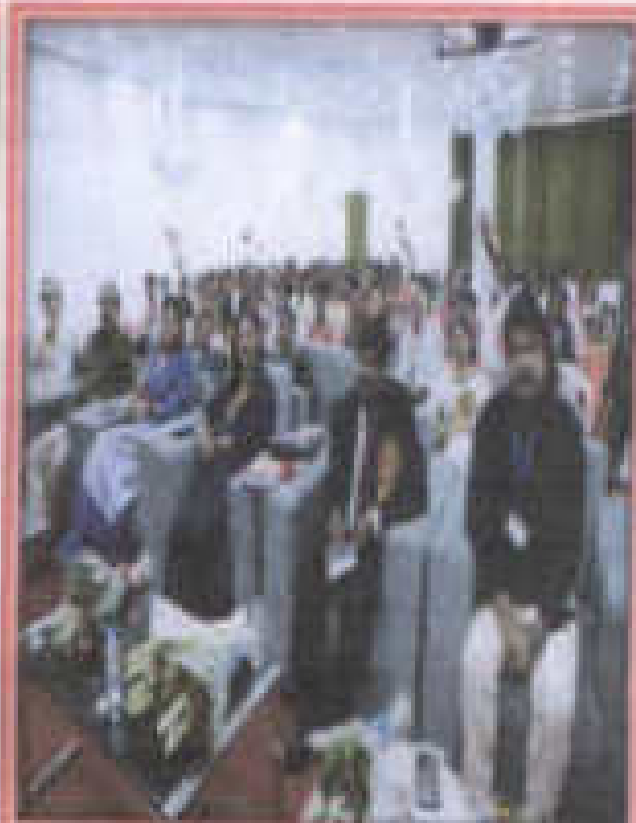

Rumi Gate :-

The 60 feet high Rumi Gate in Lucknow was constructed during the reign of Nawab Asaf-ud-Daula in 1784-86. It is said to be identical in design to an ancient portal at Constantinople in Turkey and is also referred to as Turkish Gate

Chhota Imam Bara:-

It serves as a gallery for display of life size portraits of the Nawabs of Awadh.

There are around 30 stairs to reach the Picture Gallery.

In front of the Picture gallery, there is a beautiful pond surrounded by green lawns and trees.

The portraits of Nawabs indicate the contemporary grand costumes and jewellery used in those days.



Ghanta Ghar :- Hazratnagar Clock Tower is a clock tower located in the city of Lucknow. It was built in 1881 by Nawab Nasir-ud-Din Haider for the arrival of Sir George Cooper, the first lieutenant governor of the United Provinces of Oudh. It was built at a cost of Rs 1.75 lakhs





TRAINED NURSES ASSOCIATION OF INDIA, UTTAR PRADESH STATE BRANCH

Uttar Pradesh – A religious, cultural and historical heritage!

In 1905, there was a meeting of the association of nursing superintendents in Lucknow (Uttar Pradesh) which can be considered as the first meeting of The Trained Nurses Association India and the dream came true when the TNAI was officially established in 1908. Uttar Pradesh is one of the most populous states in India as well as the most populous country subdivision in the world. The state is divided into 18 divisions and 75 districts with the capital being Lucknow. The state is bordered by Rajasthan to the west, Haryana, Himachal Pradesh and Delhi to the northwest, Uttarakhand and Nepal to the north, Bihar to the east, Madhya Pradesh to the south.

In 1950, the Uttar Pradesh state branch was officially inaugurated. Since then, it has been functioning according to the bye-laws of the TNAI. During these years, the state chapter has witnessed many ups and downs. From 1985 to 2000, the state chapter was almost inactive and it was dissolved by the TNAI head quarters. In 2001, the UP state branch had revived as a result of the constant effort of head quarters and the senior nurses in the state. An election was conducted in the same year to elect the new office bearers. Since then the Uttar Pradesh state unit of TNAI has been working tirelessly for the betterment of nurses in the states of Uttar Pradesh and Uttarakhand. The state unit has started an initiative, 'Florence Nightingale Awards' to honor the nurses across the state for their indispensable contribution towards the nursing community. In 2007, during the pre centenary conference at Banaras Hindu University 100 nurses from UP and Uttarakhand were awarded by the state chapter for their exemplary works. In the year 2008, Uttarakhand state branch of TNAI was established with the help of UP state TNAI and is functioning as an independent state branch under TNAI HQs.



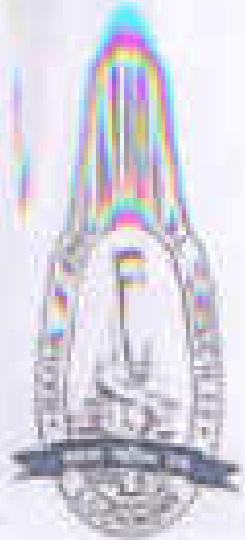

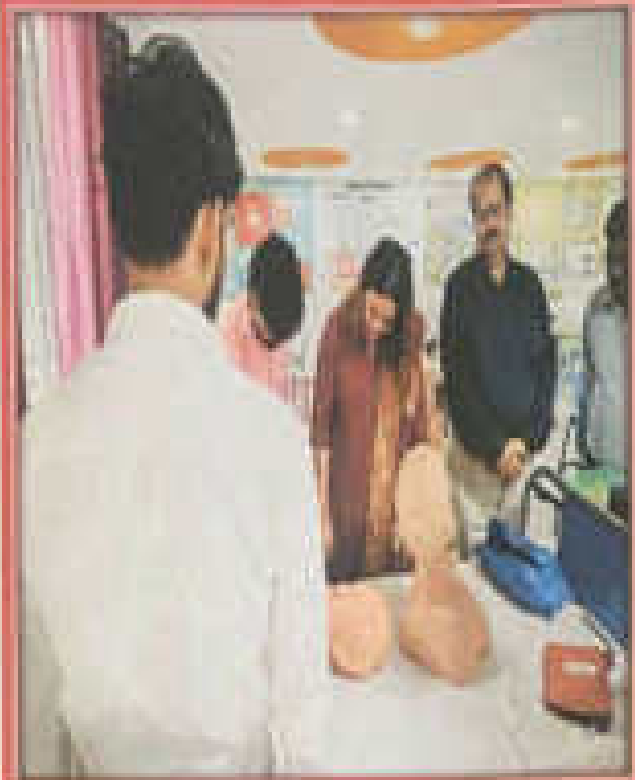
