Medical Faculty, on 25/03/2023 at Hotel Hyatt Regency, Lucknow, U.P.

On that day all the mentor phase 1 institutes were gathered for the Mentor Mentee Program Launch for that our 3 Mentee institutes i.e. Jhanvi School Of Nursing, Lucknow, Jyoti Hospital Nursing College, Dandi Dabhon, Rewa Road, Naini Prayagraj, Dr. Achal Singh Yadav Institute Of Nursing And Paramedical Science, Lucknow, were present under the our Mentor Institute "Baba College of Nursing, Lucknow.

On the same day MoU has signed between the management of the mentor institute and mentee institutes. The UPSMF was also discussed regarding the Guidelines for Mentor Mentee Partnership. Where they have discussed regarding so many key points these are mention below-

Role of Mentor Institute

The broad role of Mentor Institutes will include

Preparations

- Establish Nursing Education Study Center (NESC) within its premise and document & display its bestpractices therein.
- In discussion with its faculty, Principal & Owner, identify areas of support the Mentor Institute canoffer to a Mentee Institute.
- Propagate the identified general areas of support / offerings amongst the institutes in the state.
- Propagate the niche areas of support / offerings (which are not offered by any other Mentor Institute)amongst the institutes of UP through UPSMF.
- Facilitate visits by the representatives of Mentee Institute to NESC to understand about the bestpractices (at the cost of Mentee Institute).

Process

- In discussion with Mentee Institute, jointly develop mode of engagement / intervention to supportMentee Institute in quality improvement program.
- Ensure constitution of QI team in Mentee Institutes comprising 2 nodal persons + 6 section in-chargesamong the faculty members which will take over the role of technical support from Mentor Instituteafter 6 months of engagement between Mentor and Mentee Institutes.
- Assist Mentee Institute in conducting baseline and periodic assessments by using performancestandards tool and development of action plan.
- In case there is a need for financial support for quality improvement program (for e.g. travel cost,stay, infrastructure, etc.) guide the Mentee Institute, subject to its capacity, for the funds MenteeInstitute may require during the quality improvement interventions and document the same.

Impart guidance, training and other support as per agreed interventions within the agreed time and in spirit to the Mentee Institute.

Provide any other support as may be agreed and / or arise from time to time to sustain and further clinical and teaching standards of the Mentee Institute.

Role of Mentee Institutes

The broad role of Mentee Institutes will include

Preparation

In discussion with its faculty, Principal & Owner, identify its areas of improvement where it needs support from a Mentor Institute.

Principal & Owner of the Mentee Institute to reach out to the Principal & Owners of the appropriate Mentor Institutes to seek support in quality improvement.

In case there is a need for financial support for quality improvement program (for e.g. travel cost, stay, infrastructure, etc.), subject to its capacity, allocate adequate funds for the quality improvement interventions and document the same.

Process

In discussion with Mentor Institute, jointly develop mode of engagement / intervention to work on quality improvement program.

Nominate the faculty and ensure constitution of QI team in its institute comprising 2 nodal persons + 6 section in-charges among the faculty members which will take over the role of technical support from Mentor Institute after 6 months of engagement between Mentor and Mentee Institutes.

Ensure in time and spirit, due participation of its faculty in training and other interventions planned by Mentor Institute.

Periodically conduct, with the help of Mentor Institute, assessment and develop action plan in its Institute.

Engagement between Mentor and Mentee

The model of engagement between a Mentor Institute and a Mentee Institute will be specific to a situation and as per the need of improvement identified / agreed between the two institutes. The initiation of engagement can be from either party

i.e. after identification of its areas of improvement, a Mentee Institute can approach a Mentor Institute or a Mentor Institute after identifying its areas of support /offering for a Mentee Institute can approach Mentee Institutes.

Possible areas of Engagement / Interventions

The broad areas of engagement could include

- Faculty Development Program
- o Teaching- learning process and
- o Management of student learning at clinical & community practice areas
- o Management processes of institute includes academic process (MPR, CRP, Academic calendar, Time table etc.), policies and other guidelines
- o Learning material (check list, standard operating procedure etc.)
- Standards, Processes, Procedures and Tools
- o Understanding on quality implement processes and tools
- o Standard treatment guideline, standard operating procedure & protocols related to clinical and community teaching
- o College, clinical site, hostel related committee establishment and processes
- o Use of library, computer & skill lab for students
- Assessment
- o Student knowledge and skills evaluation process
- o Faculty teaching and demonstration skills evaluation processes
- o Processes of Internal theory and practical examination
- Infrastructure & other support
- o Hostel management & related processes
- o Feedback, grievance & redressal mechanism
- o Guidance on Infrastructure support
- Research and learning exchange programs

Operation model

In order to engage an indicative operation model could include following steps.

1. In a separate exercise, Mentor Institutes to identify areas of support it can offer to a Mentee Institute and Mentee Institute to identify its areas of improvement where it needs support from a Mentor Institute.
2. Thereafter, Principals/ Owners of Mentee Institutes to reach out to the Principals/ Owners of appropriate Mentor Institutes (as applicable).
3. Mentee Institute to share the areas of improvement identified by its team with the Mentor Institute and share any self / 3rd party baseline assessment available against the areas identified by the Mentee Institute. In case there is no baseline assessment available for any or all of the areas of improvement identified, or the two institute feel that another baseline assessment is required, the two institutes may jointly decide to conduct another baseline assessment. Cost of such baseline assessment shall be borne by the Mentee Institute.
4. After agreeing to the baseline, the Mentor and Mentee Institutes shall agree on the following against the area of improvement identified:
 - a. the target achievement with timelines,
 - b. the interventions to achieve the target,
 - c. budget allocation, if required to support quality improvement program by way of cost reimbursement to Mentor Institute (amount, manner of payment).
5. Written documentation of the above in the form of an agreement duly signed by the authorized representative of the respective institutes.


