
The mentors must undergo and fulfill the following requirements in order to be certified as a "Mentor";

Complete Pragati, Teaching Learning Process, and Clinical & Community Practice Processes training and also demonstrate understanding on nursing education quality improvement process and implementation of performance standards. For the same, earlier UPSMF provided support. For additional mentors' capacity building, the Mentor Institutes can now build the capacities through their mentor or seek the support of UPSMF in conducting the training for which the institute has to bear the cost of travel, lodging, training venue, lunch and other logistics. (UPSMF has planned training in the month of September-2023, the Mentor Institutes who wants additional Mentors, send your nomination on or before 31st August-2023).

- 1. For certification, mentors have to successfully complete supportive supervision of at least 2 Mentee Institutes, which include:

 - At least 2 faculty members in Mentee Institute trained as prospective mentors for Mentee Institute
 - 85% of faculty of at least 2 Mentee Institutes achieve teaching, demonstration and coaching skills
 - e. Successful completion of Supportive Supervision of at least 2 Mentee Institutes



Guideline for abstract submission Guidelines for Scientific Poster Presentation:

- Size of the Poster/ Flex should be approximately 30x40 inches. Ideas depicted in the poster should be relevant to the study
- Lettering and design of the poster should be bold and big enough to be seen from a distance.
- Layout of the picture, (if any) must be properly balanced to give a correct sense of proportion.
- Extra fixing of clipping cuttings or any other form on the poster should be avoided.
- The poster should depict the following: Introduction, Need and Significance, Problem statement, Objectives, Review of Literature (two relevant studies), Brief description of Methods and Procedures, Findings and Interpretation to be placed in one or two tables, Conclusion, Implications, Recommendation and References / Bibliography.
- All presenters should register for the conference.


