Event brief & highlights:-

Basic Life Support, or BLS, generally refers to a level of medical care which can be provided by trained medical personnel, including emergency medical technicians, paramedics, and by qualified bystanders for victims of life-threatening illnesses or injuries until they can be given full medical care at a hospital.

College of Nursing, Baba educational society and Medanta Hospital, Gurgaon jointly organised two days basic life support Session on 18/04/2023 and 19/04/2023 from 10am to 5pm, which was conducted by experts from Medanta hospital, Gurgaon. Around 447 participants including College of Nursing Faculties and students of all the programs (B.Sc. Nursing, G.N.M. and A.N.M.) actively participated and updated their knowledge on Paediatrics' / Adult BLS With appropriate hands on skills.

The Session was started at 10:00am, in Auditorium with Introductory Session by Mrs. Jayana Kr. Rupjee, HOD, Dept. Of Obstetrics and Gynecology Nursing.

Dr. Archana Chouhan, Principal, Baba College of Nursing, welcomed the resource persons and the delegates. Mr. Himanshu Joshi explained about cardiac arrest

and heart attack. He then explained the **7 important steps while performing CPR**. He also Demonstrated about **(AED) automatic emergency defibrillator** and explained about its uses. He then Demonstrated on Paediatrics CPR. The delegates then divided into two teams and team 1 had sessions on Paediatrics BLS, dealt by Mrs. Anjali and Mrs. Farheen. At the same time, team 2 had sessions on Adult CPR dealt by Mrs. Durba and Mrs. Manila.

After the delicious lunch, a theoretical and practical evaluatory session was held for the participants. Feedback was obtained from the faculties and the students, they assured that they shall utilize the skill gained whenever and wherever needed in the clinical setting and they also addressed that the programme was highly beneficial to them.
