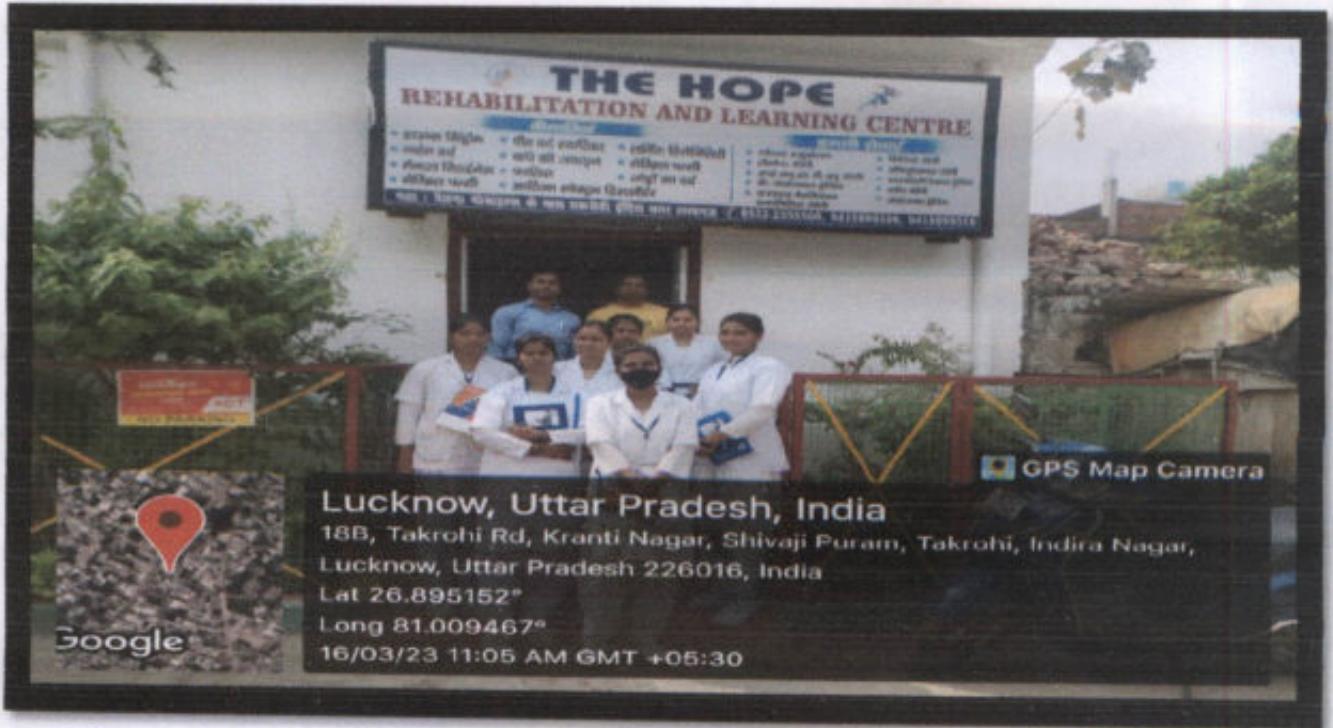

The main aim of the visit was to sensitize students towards children with disabilities like Cerebral Palsy, Autism, Mental retardation, Speech and Hearing problems, etc. Students learned about the challenges faced by these children and their families. Major treatment modalities included physiotherapy sessions conducted to improve muscle coordination in cerebral palsy patients.

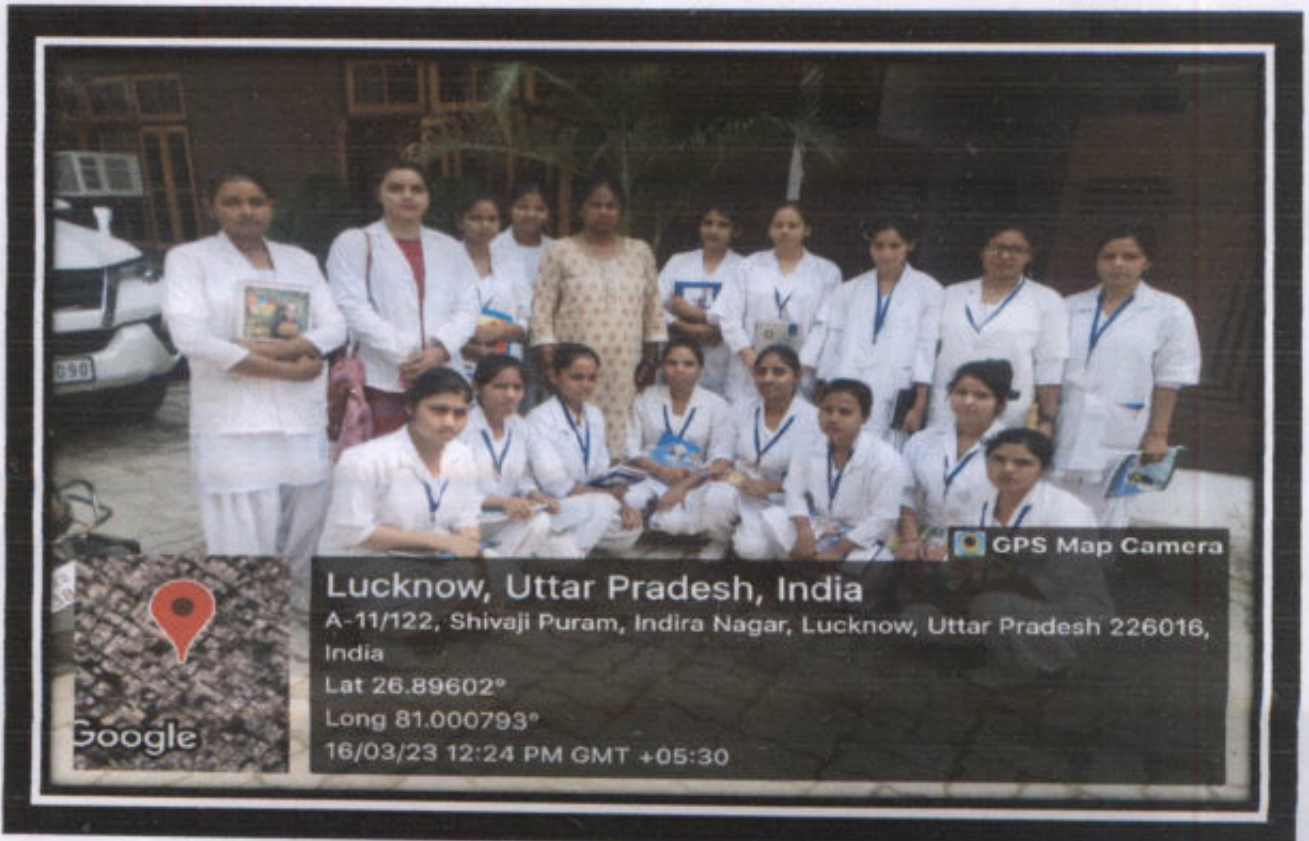
Students also visited the preparatory school in Hope and interacted with students who were severe intellectually impaired. Their trainer gave them basic training in Activities of Daily Living and teaches them reading and writing skills then refer them to special schools afterwards.

Visit was really informative for all students. They got good amount of information about the over all procedure usually carried out in water purification. There were 90 students are visited to the plant along with 3 teaching faculty.

OBJECTIVES OF VISIT:

To observe the setup of the plant.

To gain knowledge regarding the overall process of purification.

To know about how the purified water is supplies to the areas.

WATER PURIFICATION PROCESS:

Collection

Coagulation


Flocculation

Filtration

Disinfection

Reservoir

The visit started from the initial tank where the waste water of city and industries is collected. Then that flow is collected from the inlet pipe and removes the larger solid inorganic material such as paper, plastic, etc.

The water for this plant is supplied from Indira Dam. Then water sent in the aeration tank it is then stored in settling tank. In further process for the filtration of water.

After this process water send to the further two tank called settling tank. In this tank aerated water mixed with alum known chemical coagulation this process all dirt will settle in down in the tank. For separating dirt from water a type of rotor is used and this process is known as flocculation.


Next process water is then store in to the filter bed. 1 filter bed , 2 filter bed, 3 filter bed etc the process proceed by transferring the water into the pump house for chlorination. Once the chlorination process over the water is ready for used and water is stored into the main tank with the capacity of over 12.5 lac liters.

From this visit we get the information and practical knowledge about the physio-chemical treatment of waste water and components used in purification plant. Some test should be performing for general discussion with experts in the industry.

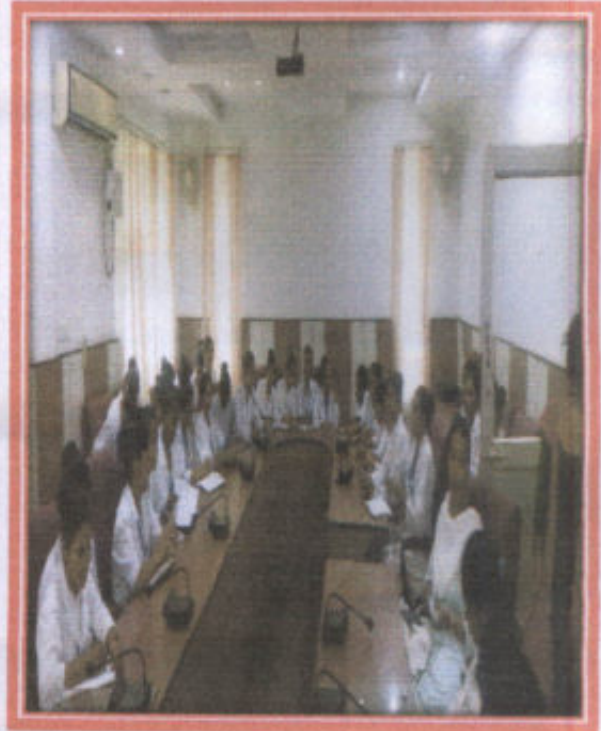
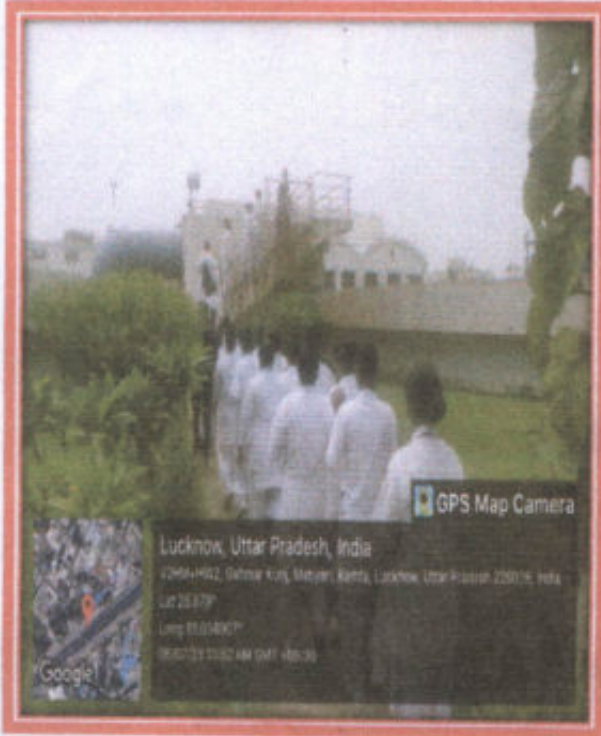

Over two decades ago, the FAO (Food and Agriculture Organization) established a global Milk Day to emphasize the importance of milk in our lives and societies and draw attention to the dairy industry and popularize its numerous operative. This year's theme is “Enjoy Dairy”, which encourages people across the world to participate actively to promote the importance of milk as global food and to facilitate the dairy industry. The theme also marks the need to improve waste management in the dairy sector in order to make the industry more sustainable.

The visit was planned to make students recognize the value of milk in our lives and the significance of the dairy sector. The whole activity was carried out at the ‘**LUCKNOW PRODUCER’S CO-OPERATIVE MILK UNION LIMITED**’ also known as ‘**PARAG NEW DAIRY PLANT, CHAK GANJARIA, SULTANPUR ROAD, LUCKNOW**’,

Uttar Pradesh, 226002. The Parag Dairy is one of the oldest Dairy in India. It was established in 1938. The new plant located at Sultanpur road was launched in the year 2021. The plant consists of the following units:

1. CIP (Cleaning In Place)
2. Quality Assurance Lab
3. Milk and milk product storage rooms
4. Milk products manufacturing units (Paneer, Ghee, Butter, Khoa, Chenna kheer)
5. Packaging unit
6. Butter stored room

The plant consists of 4 silos having a capacity of 60,000 litres each. They procure milk from 15 nearby districts and provide bulk milk coolers to prevent the spoilage of milk. Prashant Arya, Marketing Director, Parag dairy, Lucknow and their expert team members provided fruitful information about the milk procurement system, platform test, pre-heating process, milk processes, pasteurization, homogenization, Quality Assurance and Quality Control Lab, and different production units of Parag milk and milk products. An objective to provide real-life exposure to the students about the dairy industry and their mode of operation.

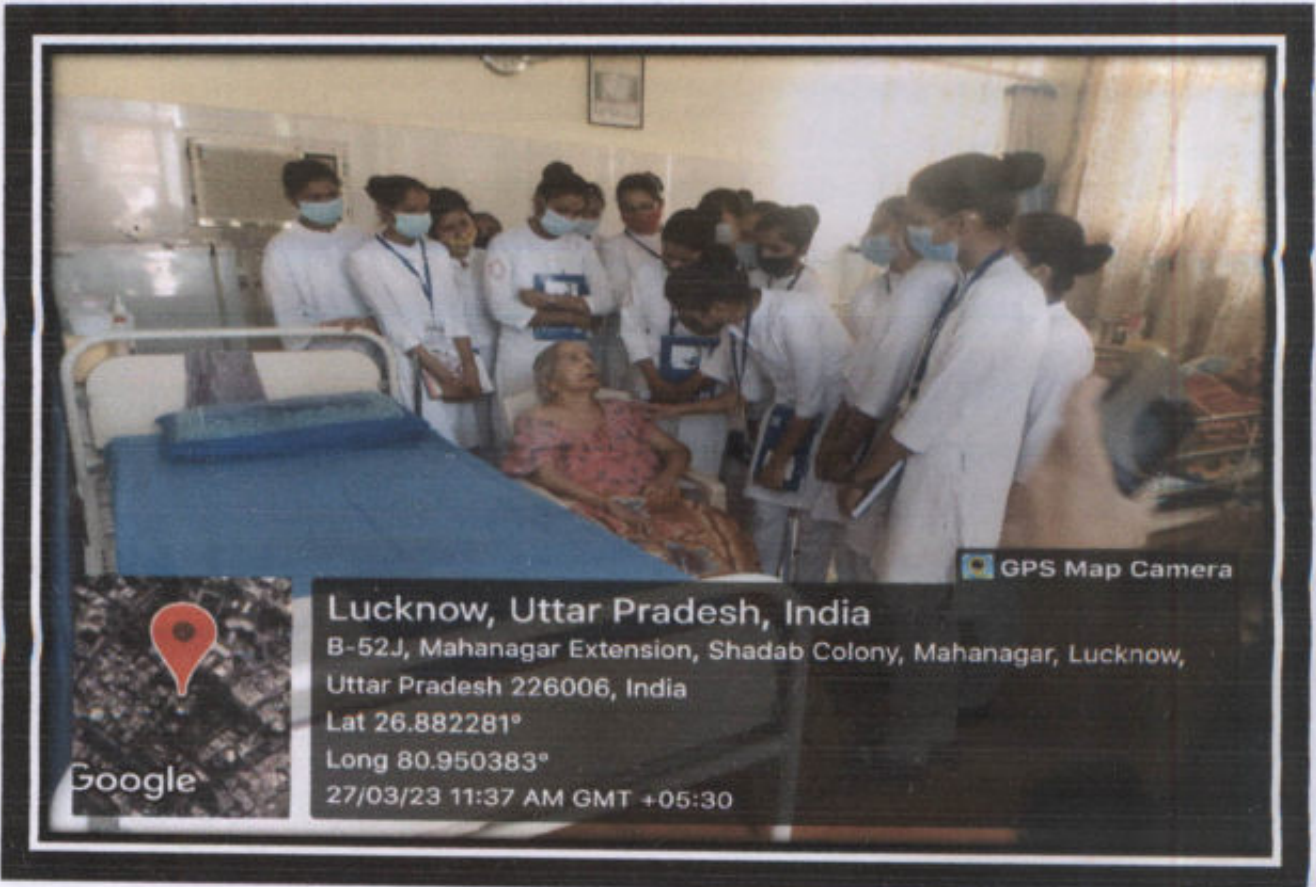

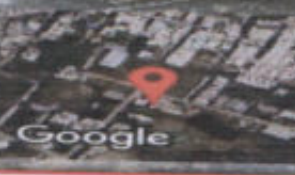
