Gender equality was highlight under the theme "Gender equality today for a sustainable tomorrow", the celebration came to end with group photo session.



- 5. Waist Rotation (10 clock & anti clock wise)
- 6. Knee Rotation (10 clock & anti clock wise)
- 7. Ankle Rotation (10 clock & anti clock wise)

STANDING ASANAS


- Surya Namaskar (11 times)

SITTING ASANAS


- 1. Legs- Up and down (10 Times)
